ADMISSION POLICY

1. Children are ordinarily admitted to K.G or class 1. Admissions are completed in March.
2. All students seeking admission, register themselves through a prescribed form. Meeting the child with both the parents is a prerequisite.
3. Selection of a candidate for admission rests on the discretion of the selection committee.
4. Consideration is given to eligible Christian and economically backward students. Girls are given preference.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO PARENTS

1. Parents must see that their child comes to school five minutes before the assembly.
2. The person who comes to take the child must bring the identity card with them daily.
3. Parents are expected to read the student's diary for any information regarding the school.
4. Parents are requested to meet the Principal and the class teacher from time to time.
5. Parents are expected to send the child neat and clean to the school.
