### PRAYER BEFORE TIFFIN

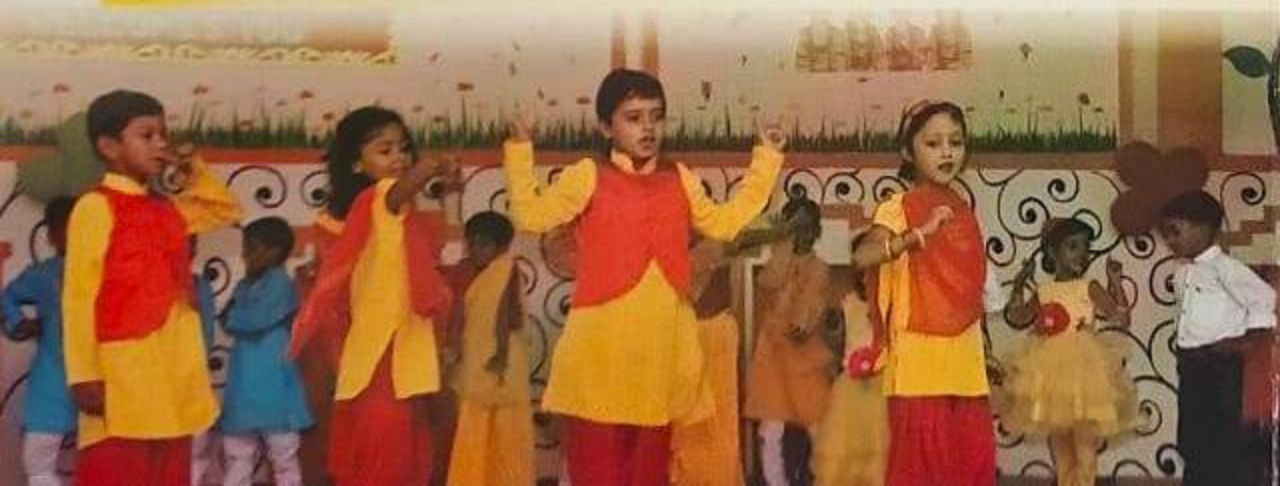
O God, bless us and bless the food which we are going to eat.

I am truly sorry if I have hurt anyone by word or deed. Help me, God to be good to others always.



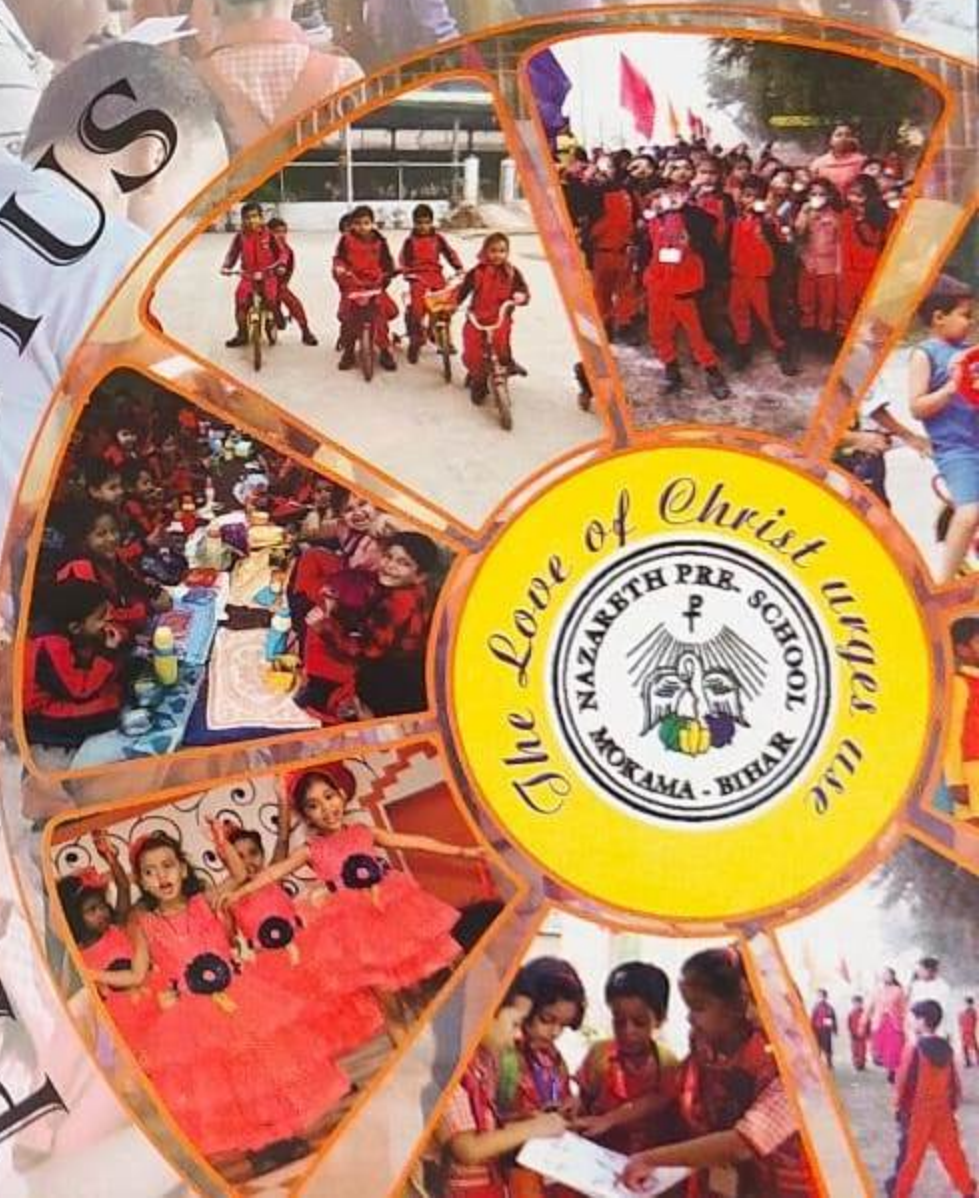

## RECOMMENDATIONS TO PARENTS:
